## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### INTRODUCTION

1. This edition continues the series of publications on a financial year basis presenting statistical information on the scheduled operations of international airlines operating into/out of Australia.
2. The figures in this publication were obtained from reports submitted by scheduled international carriers and are the best available at the time of publication.

### COVERAGE

3. These statistics show **uplift/discharge** data – These data detail, by direction, the revenue traffic between the actual points of uplift and discharge within each flight, aggregated for all flights within the period. It shows the movement of traffic between two airports not necessarily directly connected but within the same flight number. Typically, flight numbers change when an aircraft reaches its home country. This means that uplift/discharge data for the port in the operator's home country are likely to be overstated by traffic whose origin/destination point is beyond that port. For example, uplift/discharge traffic reported in this publication as Singapore could include traffic whose origin/destination is Europe.
4. These statistics cover **revenue** traffic carried by the operators of scheduled regular public international air transport services only and **do not include charter traffic**.
5. Some airlines (generally, dedicated freighter operators) operate scheduled services into Australia but operate non-scheduled services out of Australia and therefore outbound activity is not recorded in this data collection.

### PRODUCTION AND INTERPRETATION

6. **Tables 1 to 3** show the country of the relevant uplift or discharge port served by that airline. For example, traffic uplifted/discharged between Sydney and Singapore by British Airways would be shown as Singapore traffic in Tables 1 to 3.
7. **Table 4** shows figures for the country of service (or route) for each airline and therefore may not equate to the data in Tables 1 to 3. For example, the British Airways UK service identified in Table 4 could include passengers uplifted or discharged in Singapore or Thailand as well as the UK; these passengers would be shown individually under those countries in Tables 1 to 3. The difference in treatment of data between Tables 1 to 3 and Table 4 is necessary in order to work out a meaningful Seat Utilisation figure for Table 4.

Figures shown in Table 4 may include **total traffic** into and out of Australia for airlines that fly through Australia (also necessary in order to work out a meaningful Seat Utilisation figure). Therefore, figures in Table 4 may not equate to figures in Tables 1 to 3. For example, passengers carried by Qantas Airways from New Zealand **via** Australia to the UK will be included in Table 4 but will not be included in Tables 1 to 3 as these passengers were not uplifted/discharged in Australia.

8. **Tables 6 and 7** – show uplift/discharge passenger and freight data for directly connected city pairs. Statistics reported in these tables for city pairs without direct international flight connections, reflect carriage on interconnecting domestic services by Australian carriers within Australia or foreign carriers in their home countries. This traffic should be interpreted as increasing the volume of traffic between the primary international ports rather than as an indicator of traffic volume between ports without direct international flight connections. It should be noted however, that there is no double counting of traffic. For example, there is no direct connection between Brisbane and Los Angeles and the traffic reported between Brisbane and Los Angeles should be interpreted as adding to traffic between Sydney and Los Angeles.
9. Where figures have been rounded, discrepancies may occur between sums of component items and totals, and in percentage changes which are derived from figures prior to rounding.
10. Published figures may be revised where figures missing at the time of publication are received or misreporting/miscalculation necessitates revisions.

## DEFINITIONS

11. The following definitions have been used in this publication:

- (a) Aircraft Movement: A landing or a take off.
- (b) Freight: The aggregate of all revenue freight uplifted.
- (c) Mail: The aggregate of all mail uplifted.
- (d) Revenue Passengers: The aggregate of all passengers paying 25% or more of the standard air fare (as defined by ICAO) – see paragraph 13 below.
- (e) Seat Utilisation: The ratio of passengers carried to seats available, expressed as a percentage.
- (f) Seats Available: Generally based on standard aircraft configuration, the aggregate of seats available on all flights operated over a particular service.
- (g) Services: Scheduled flights over authorised routes which are listed according to the main ports involved.

## CHANGES IN THIS PUBLICATION

- 12. Code Share Arrangements - Reporting of traffic split by airline code for code share arrangements has been phased out from January 2000. ALL traffic carried is reported under the operating airline regardless of code share arrangements for July 2000 and onwards. Tables 1 to 4 are footnoted to indicate airlines that were affected by this change.
- 13. Revenue Passenger Definition - The following New definition was phased in from January 2000 and fully implemented for July 2000 and onwards: All passengers paying any fare (frequent flyer redemption passengers will be regarded as revenue passengers). In most cases, Revenue Passengers will now include all passengers excluding Free Of Charge passengers and positioning crew.
- 14. Passenger Numbers - The Revenue Passenger definition change when fully implemented is expected to result in approximately a three per cent increase in passenger numbers. Due to the phased introduction of this change, growth in passenger numbers for January to June 2000 when compared to January to June 1999 will also include a component due to the definition change.
- 15. Airline Market Shares - Due to the phased introduction of the above changes (some airlines implemented the changes between January and June 2000 while others did not do so until July 2000), airline market shares will not be accurate for January to June 2000 and hence, also for the year ended June 2000 figures in this publication.

# INTERNATIONAL AVIATION INDUSTRY ANALYSIS

## YEAR ENDED JUNE 2000

### General

The year ended June 2000 saw an increase of 6.9% in the number of revenue passengers carried on international scheduled air services to and from Australia when compared with the previous year. This compares to an increase of 3.4% for 1998-99 over 1997-98. The increase in freight carried, 1999-00 over 1998-99 was 6.4% compared to a decrease of 0.01% for 1998-99 over 1997-98.

On a world wide basis, provisional figures from the International Civil Aviation Organisation indicate that scheduled airlines (of contracting states) performing international services, recorded a 7% increase for passengers carried and a 9% increase for freight carried for 1999 over 1998 (unfortunately, no data is available for 1999-00 over 1998-99).

### Passengers

Chart 1 shows inbound and outbound passenger traffic for the years ended June 1990 to 2000. The average annual growth for inbound traffic was 6.5% and 6.6% for outbound traffic. The increase for 1999-00 over 1998-99 was 6.5% for inbound traffic and 7.3% for outbound traffic. This shows a recovery in year on year growth levels after 1997-98 and 1998-99 which possibly as a result of the Asian economic crisis, recorded the lowest year on year growth levels since 1990-91 when traffic was affected by the Gulf War. The greatest increase over the previous year occurred in the year ended June 1996 when inbound and outbound traffic increased by 9.6%.

### Passengers by City Pairs

The top ten city pairs for the year ended June 2000 represented 37.0% of the total passenger traffic. This compares with 36.1% for 1998-99 and 34.4% for 1997-98. The distribution of traffic amongst the top ten city pairs as a percentage of total passengers for the latest year is shown in Chart 2.

Table 1 shows total passenger traffic by city pairs for the years ended June 1998, 1999 and 2000. Of the top ten city pairs Auckland/Sydney remains the busiest with 5.5% of the total for the latest year. Auckland/Sydney (15.0%) has also recorded the most significant increase for the year ended June 2000, followed by Singapore/Sydney (14.6%) and Singapore/Melbourne (13.9%). None of the major routes recorded a decrease in traffic levels for the same period.

### Airline Market Share - Passengers

The top ten carriers for the year ended June 2000 accounted for 83.5% of the total passenger market (see Chart 3), compared with 82.7% in 1998-99 and 80.9% in 1997-98. The market share attributable to Australian carriers for the year ended June 2000 of 37.8%, compares with 39.7% in 1998-99 and 41.8% in 1997-98.

During 1999-00, 60 international scheduled airlines operated services to/from Australia of which 7 were dedicated freight only operators. This compares to a total of 56 international scheduled airlines during 1998-99 of which 6 were dedicated freight only operators. Total flights of 86.8 thousand and seats of 22.9 million provided by the airlines into and out of Australia during 1999-00 compares to 80.5 thousand flights and 21.6 million seats in 1998-99 and 77.8 thousand flights and 21.6 million seats in 1997-98. Overall seat utilisation percentage (load factor) was 69.3% in 1999-00, 68.9% in 1998-99 and 66.7% in 1997-98.

### Freight

The average annual growth for inbound freight was 6.8% over the last ten years and 6.9% for outbound freight. Asian Express Airlines, Cargolux Airlines International, Connie Kalitta Services, Federal Express Corporation, Martinair Holland, Polar Air Cargo and United Parcel Service operated dedicated freighter services to/from Australia during 2000. As well as these freight only operators, Air New Zealand, Ansett Australia (Ansett International Cargo), Cathay Pacific, China Airlines, Korean Air, Malaysia Airlines, Qantas Airways and Singapore Airlines provided dedicated freighter services in addition to their regular passenger services. Qantas Airways had the largest share of freight carried to and from Australia in 1999-00 with 25.5% of the total, followed by Singapore Airlines with 15.2% and Air New Zealand with 10.0%. During 1999-00, approximately 30% to 35% of inbound freight and 10% to 15% of outbound freight was carried on dedicated freight aircraft (the rest was carried as belly-hold on passenger services).

### **Freight by City Pairs**

Table 2 shows total freight carried by city pairs for the years ended June 1998, 1999 and 2000. The top ten city pairs for the year ended June 2000 accounted for 49.9% of total freight traffic, compared with 48.4% for 1998-99 and 45.5% for 1997-98. Auckland/Sydney remains the major contributor with 7.9% of the total freight for the latest year. Kuala Lumpur/Melbourne (42.2%), Singapore/Brisbane (41.8%) and Singapore/Melbourne (28.1%) recorded the most significant increases for the year ended June 2000. Hong Kong/Sydney (-10.1%) and Auckland/Sydney (-0.4%) recorded decreases in freight carried over the same period.

### **Passengers by Major Country**

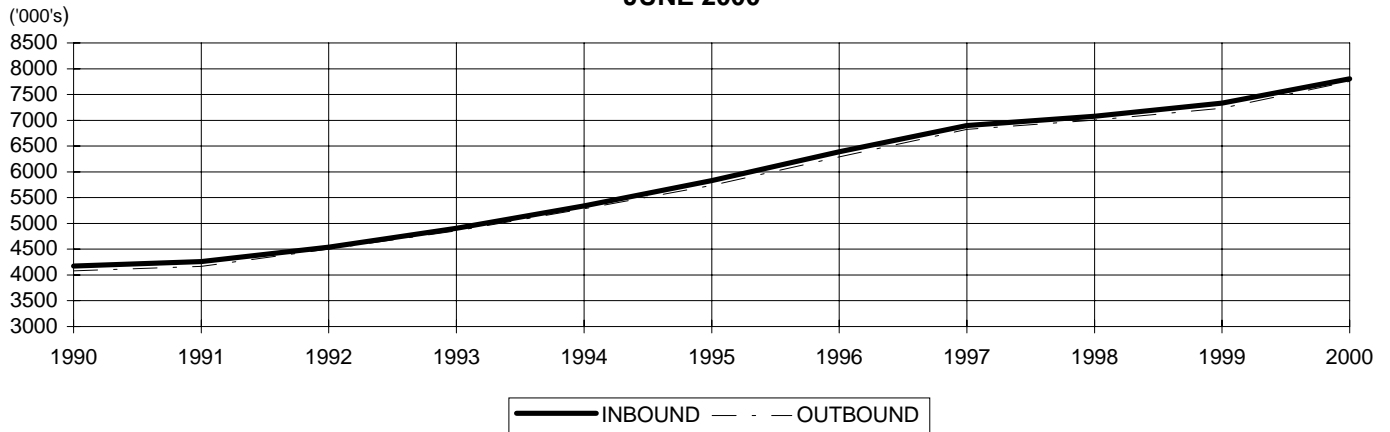
Table 3 provides a breakdown of passenger traffic by major country for the years ended June 1998, 1999 and 2000. The ten major countries for the years ended June 2000 accounted for 83.4% of total passenger traffic. This compares to 83.4% again for 1998-99 and 82.3% for 1997-98. New Zealand was the major contributor in each of the three years, with 19.6% of the total market in the latest year, 19.0% in 1998-99 and 18.6% in 1997-98. It has also recorded strong (10.3%) growth for 1999-00. Malaysia (23.4%), Singapore (12.6%) and UK (12.3%) recorded the most significant increases for the year ended June 2000. Of the major countries, Indonesia (-24.1%) and Japan (-2.4%) recorded decreases in traffic over the same period.

### **Passenger Movements at International Airports**

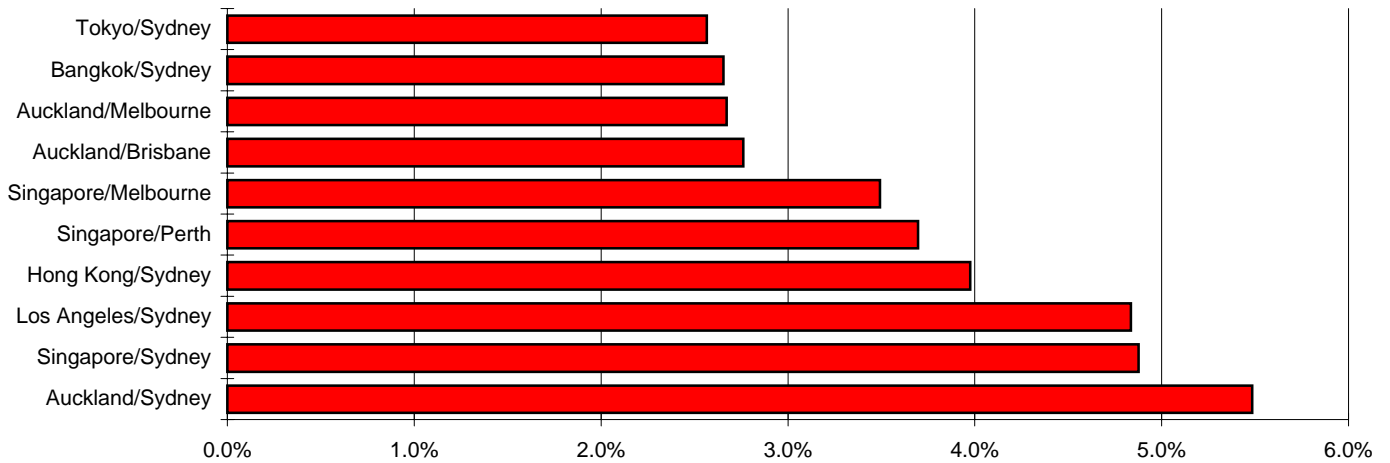
Table 4 provides a breakdown of passenger traffic through Australian international airports for the years ended June 1998, 1999 and 2000. Sydney accounted for 49.4% of the total passenger traffic for the latest year, followed by Melbourne with 18.2% and Brisbane with 15.6%. Melbourne and Sydney have shown steady growth over the two year period, with passenger traffic through Melbourne increasing by 17.5% and through Sydney by 12.5%.

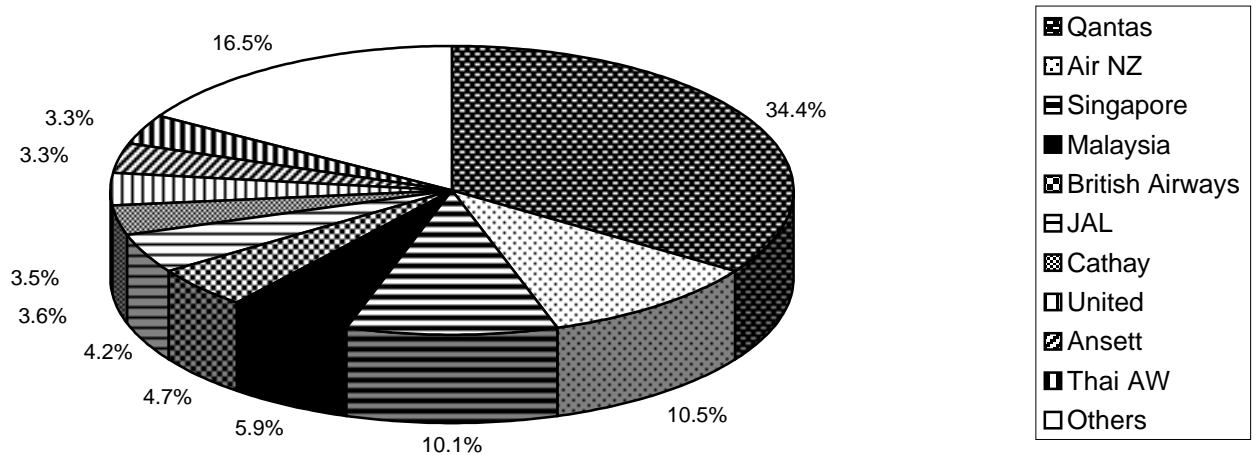
**CHART 1: PASSENGERS CARRIED, YEARS ENDED JUNE 1990 TO JUNE 2000**

- A total of 60 international scheduled airlines operated services to/from Australia during 1999-00 (including those airlines operating via code share arrangements and dedicated freight airlines).

- The year ended June 2000 saw an increase of 6.9% in the number of revenue passengers carried on international scheduled air services to and from Australia when compared with the previous year.
- In terms of freight carried, 1999-00 saw an increase of 6.4% when compared with 1998-99.
- The top five airlines in terms of passengers carried were Qantas Airways (34.4% of total), Air New Zealand (10.5%), Singapore Airlines (10.1%), Malaysia Airlines (5.9%) and British Airways (4.7%).
- The top five airlines in terms of freight carried were Qantas Airways (25.5% of total), Singapore Airlines (15.2%), Air New Zealand (10.0%), Cathay Pacific Airways (6.7%) and Malaysia Airlines (5.8%).
- The top five city pairs in terms of passengers carried were Auckland/Sydney (5.5% of total), Singapore/Sydney (4.9%), Los Angeles/Sydney (4.8%), Hong Kong/Sydney (4.0%) and Singapore/Perth (3.7%).
- The top five city pairs in terms of freight carried were Auckland/Sydney (7.9% of total), Singapore/Melbourne (7.7%), Singapore/Sydney (6.5%), Los Angeles/Sydney (5.2%) and Auckland/Melbourne (4.9%).
- Sydney accounted for 49.4% of total passenger traffic and for 49.0% of total freight traffic during 2000. Melbourne was the next busiest airport with 18.2% of passenger traffic and 29.2% of freight traffic, followed by Brisbane with 15.6% of passenger traffic and 11.3% of freight traffic.
